This three-year-old alternative fair--which also takes place during Basel Miami--recruits avant-garde galleries, including New York's Glowlab, Radau in Miami and Yum Yum Factory in Brooklyn, N.Y., which represent artists such as Jason Cantoro, Thomas Hart and guerrilla installation artist Greg Haberny. The fair's name is a nod to Dada artist Marcel Duchamp's *Fountain*, the urinal sculpture that caused a wave of excitement in the art world back in 1917 because of its subversive message.
